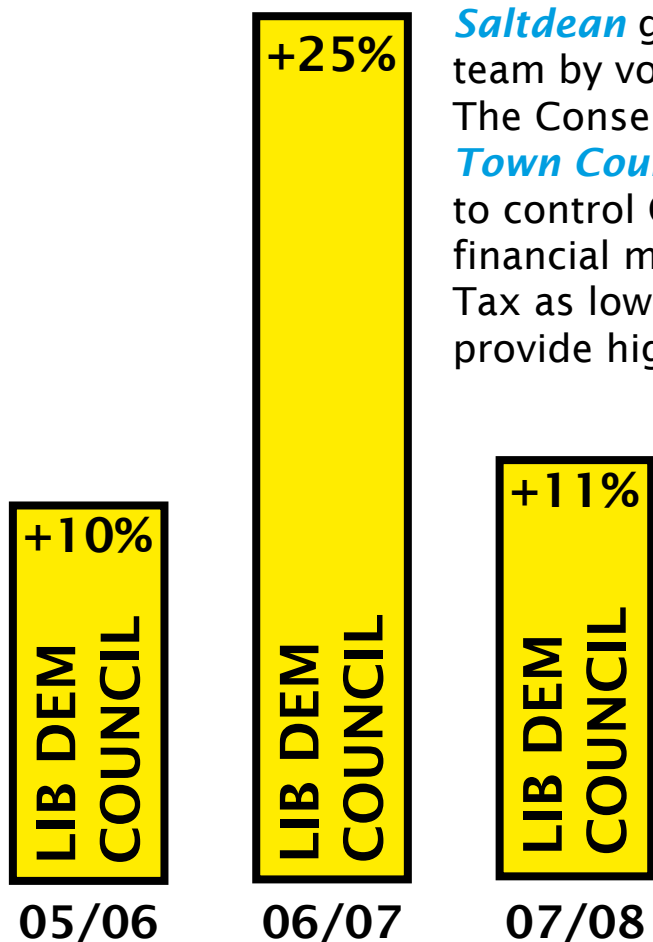

East Saltdean Conservatives deliver on their lower Town Council Tax promise: 1.5%



On Thursday February 7th, the people of *East Saltdean* get the chance to stick with a winning team by voting for local businessman Brian Page. The Conservatives took control of the *Telscombe Town Council* in May of last year and promised to control Council Tax by introducing tighter financial management with a plan to keep Council Tax as low as possible. Conservatives want to provide high quality local services in line with what residents can afford. This year's Telscombe Town Council increase is amongst the lowest across the County.

At Lewes District, Council Tax has **TRIPLED** under the Lib Dems in the last 12 years, hitting those on lower incomes hardest.

Conservative policies include:

Abolishing stamp duty for nine out of ten first-time buyers and increasing threshold for inheritance tax to £1m;

Ending Labour's early prisoner release scheme, and scrapping ID cards and using some of the funds to build more prison places;

Cutting police paperwork so that officers can spend more time out on patrol;

Scrapping tests for seven year olds, making sure that every child who is capable of doing so can read, and imposing discipline in the classroom;

Offering a referendum on the EU Treaty - the European Constitution in all but name;

Introducing a new system of decentralised energy production, helping to improve energy efficiency and reduce greenhouse gases we produce;

Shifting the burden of tax away from families and onto pollution;

Increase spending on the NHS - and making sure that the money is better spent by increasing out-of-hours duty services, protecting Hospitals and putting patients first.

£3.2 million grant for Downlands



East Saltdean & Telscombe Cliffs Conservative County Councillors John Livings & Phil Howson are over the moon with the announcement that Conservative controlled ESCC have secured a £3.2 million Government grant towards replacing facilities lost last summer when Downlands was closed. This adds to some £3 million already committed by Saxon Weald Housing Association towards 41 units of sheltered accommodation and a further commitment of £400,000 from County Council, all working in partnership with East Sussex Downs & Weald Primary Care Trust. This ensures that a modern treatment and activity centre will be built in Peacehaven.

Carers and pensioners were outraged when the centre, used by some 70 people was earmarked for closure to save money. County Councillors John Livings & Phil Howson opposed the closure and demanded that the coastal strip from East Saltdean to Seaford needed **MORE** not less facilities for the ever increasing number of elderly and disabled residents in our area.
